Enjoy firsthand accounts from doctors who made a unique contribution to medical history covering the period when medical knowledge – and practice – was expanded explosively after WW2 in Newcastle. 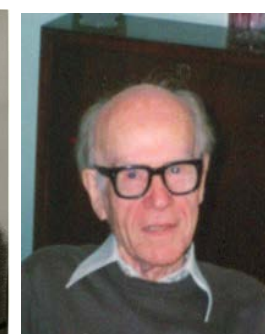

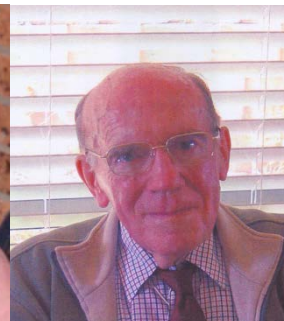
